Serving and defending the interests of the 2,800 farmers permanently registered in the agricultural Register, the Chamber of Agriculture (CANC) is an administrative public institution which animates and federates all the actors of the agricultural world in New Caledonia. Its General Assembly is composed of 35 farmers and agricultural workers elected. The CANC contributes to agricultural reforms, perpetuates and develops agriculture, facilitates the transmission of agricultural holdings and accompanies farmers towards sustainable development.

Throughout the territory, CANC delivers local services to farmers by providing information, training, consultancy, promotion and development of structures. The Chamber also manages the Nessadiou breeding station, the fertilizer dock, the wholesale market, the agricultural machining platform and since 2013, the plant standardization at the border of Tontouta Airport area (PNVF). The PNVF teams provide sanitary inspection and fruit and vegetable packaging (HACCP approvals) for companies exporting mainly to New Zealand and Australia.

In 2014, the Chamber of Agriculture established a regional technical cooperation service to develop economic and technical exchanges in the agricultural and rural fields between the various actors in the Pacific. In particular, CANC has established relations with French Polynesia, Wallis and Futuna, Vanuatu and Fiji. For better regional and international integration of New Caledonia, CANC seeks to integrate more into professional networks such as CLEI, CPS, POET Com, PIFON, ACAP, or RITA.
