OPT

As a public institution, the New Caledonia postal and telecommunications Office (OPT-NC) provides a mission of spatial planning and development to serve the people, businesses and communities. OPT-NC is also a major player in the local economy and the regional and international integration of New Caledonia with regard to its Telecom and postal trades. Thus, the OPT-NC develops infrastructures, ensures spatial planning in digital matters and local services, delivers essential services in postal, Telecom, banking and applies a balanced tariff policy, validated by the Government. OPT-NC also contributes to the external influence of New Caledonia overseas.

The OPT-NC has more than 1,200 agents and a diversity of missions at the heart of the daily operations of New-Caledonians through:

- a sales network (57 agencies, 146 ATMs, 400 resellers Liberté recharge cards, 24 mobile partner shops, 3 call centres, 1 financial centre),
- a network of technical centres (7 technical centres and 10 service units) and nearly 400 technical sites throughout New Caledonia.
- a postal distribution network (1 postal processing centre, 2 mail distribution centres, 58 home distribution tours, 54 mobile post tours, 52,500 mailboxes served).

In 2017, the OPT-NC achieved a total turnover (CA) of 23.9 billion XPF divided between its 3 trades: telecommunications (20.9 billion XPF of CA, or 88% of the total turnover of the OPT-NC), parcel mail (2.3 billion XPF of CA, or 10%) financial services (597 million XPF, or 2%).

As part of the social, cultural and economic development to the benefit of New-Caledonians, the OPT-NC contributes to equal opportunities, the attractiveness of the country and the competitiveness of the New-Caledonian economy.
